Logan Motorway Enhancement Project

As many locals will no doubt be aware, the \$512 million Logan Enhancement Project includes upgrading parts of the Logan and Gateway Extension motorways, improving key congestion hot spots (Mt Lindesay Highway/Beaudesert Road interchange and the Wembley Road/Logan Motorway interchange) and constructing new south-facing ramps at Compton Road. Early works for the project are now well underway and on-track to be completed in late May 2017. The next round of community information sessions are just around the corner where you can drop-in to speak to members of the project team and find out more about the project as they gear up for construction in the coming months.
