New Flashing Lights at Sunnybank Hills State School and Runcorn State High

Keep an eye out for new flashing lights that have recently been installed on Symons Rd and Borella Rd, Sunnybank Hills and Hill Rd, Runcorn. These lights are part of the Palaszczuk Government flashing school zone light program which has installed over 740 signs across Queensland. These flashing signs make schools zones safer and play an important role alerting motorists that they are entering a school zone, reminding drivers to slow down and keep an eye out for children. The signs only flash on school days and during school zone times.



Energy Appliance Rebate

Did you know that you can now jump online and apply for rebates of up to \$300 on energy efficient appliances to save on your electricity bill? These rebates are part of the Palaszczuk Government's \$2 billion Affordable Energy Plan to help Queenslanders save on their power bills. The rebates apply to new, eligible four-star or higher appliances purchased from 1 January 2018: \$200 for washing machines; \$250 for fridges and \$300 for air conditioners. Rebates are limited to one per household. Both shoppers and businesses have told me they are over the moon for the new appliance rebate.
