New Noise Barriers for Kuraby and Eight Mile Plains

Residents of Kuraby and Eight Mile Plains will benefit from the construction of new noise barriers along the Logan and Gateway Extension Motorways.

Member for Stretton Duncan Pegg welcomed Phase II of the Transurban Queensland Noise Management Program (NMP II) with construction scheduled to commence in early 2017 and be completed in mid-2017, weather permitting.

“I welcome the construction of these new noise barriers,” Mr Pegg said.

“They will reduce traffic noise, and will be good for residents who live near the motorway.”

“Noise barriers will be built at Kuraby, near Clifford Close and Hockey Street. There will also be new noise barriers at Eight Mile Plains, near Raymond Road,” he said.

These new barriers will benefit adjacent residents by reducing the level of noise from motorway traffic.

The new barriers at Eight Mile Plains and Kuraby will be located within the road corridor and will not require any changes to residential boundary fences.
