



EAL Scholarship Guidelines and application

The goal of the scholarship is to serve as a support to Austin's early-career arts professionals to cultivate a network of strong, knowledgeable arts leaders in Austin.

Applicant Eligibility

Must have at least one year, but less than 10 years, full time experience in arts or arts administration. Must not be a full time student. Must be a resident of the Greater Austin area.

What the Scholarship will fund

- Professional Development Workshops/Classes
- Conference/Seminar Attendance
- Professional Association Membership
- Application Fees

Scholarship applications are open twice a year. Awardees may only receive funds once in a calendar year. The scholarships will be awarded based on financial need. If awarded you will be required to complete a brief report, which will be due 30 days after the completion of the funded activity.

The current round of applications will fund activities between January 1 and June 30, 2018. Applications are due December 1 by 11:59pm.

The scholarships will be given out in amounts up to \$200.
