Mr. Craig Adams,

I'm writing to inform you that by May 2, 2016 Earth Quaker Action Team (EQAT) expects to hear PECO's response to the short-term demands that we presented to PECO representatives during two meetings in September and October of 2015. Since then, we have visited six times, inviting PECO to boost economic development in North Philadelphia through solar rooftop installation. Sadly, we have not received a clear commitment from the company, though PECO's deadline for sourcing its 2016 increase is approaching.

If PECO has not told EQAT and/or the public in writing by 12 pm May 2, 2016 that it will source its required 2016 solar energy increase from suitable rooftops in North Philadelphia—prioritizing installation by companies training and employing local workers, particularly unionized workers and people of color from high unemployment areas of North Philadelphia—we will take it as a refusal and blow the whistle on PECO.

Frankly, much more needs to be done to mitigate both catastrophic climate change and the unconscionable economic inequality in our region. These short-term demands offer PECO an opportunity to take a step in the right direction. If PECO does not publically commit to these steps by 12 pm May 2, 2016, **EQAT will blow the whistle on PECO**, exposing the fact that it is not the reliable, future-oriented community leader it claims to be.
