The Hub is implemented by Development Alternatives Inc. (DAI).

Rwanda Standards Board (RSB) is a public institution established by Rwanda Government Legislation N° 50/2013 of 28/06/2013 determining the mission, organization and functioning of the Rwanda Standards Board to undertake all activities pertaining to the development of Standards, Conformity Assessment and Metrology services in the country. The current Rwanda Standards catalogue is not easily accessible, hard to be updated and does not provide enough information to customers. As a result, customers find it difficult to make a quick and informed decision on buying Rwanda standards.

The Hub is therefore seeking applications from an individual ICT Consultant to assess the level of digitization of standards sales and library services and determination of the requirements/specifications for development of national webstore including infrastructure to be undertaken from June to July 2019.
