Too many coastal areas around Australia have been damaged irreparably. We want a better future for Darwin Harbour, and now is our chance.

Darwin has a unique coastal lifestyle worth protecting. A strong plan to safeguard our Harbour is essential if we are to maintain its environmental, cultural, social and economic values for the enjoyment of future generations.

The development of a strategy for Darwin Harbour is underway, yet not complete.

As a community of proud Territorians, we can work to ensure Darwin Harbour is managed and protected for all, now and into the future.
