Kevin Freeman interviews Nick Adams, founder of The Foundation for Liberty and American Greatness (FLAG). Nick moved to America from Australia to help protect America exceptionalism. Nick brings his insights to what America really means to the rest of the world. He is author of "Green Card Warrior" and "Retaking America".

1. The importance of America as the great melting pot, verses silos of different cultures:

- The United States of America was always known as being a place when somebody immigrated, they immediately became an American first.

Historically, Americans were able to integrate their people more quickly than any other country around shared values.

- Even though that's changing, America still remains far better than Germany, England, or Australia where you see specific segregated communities.
- The assimilation of American Values is important, and it is not happening with our current open border policies. The Constitution and Bill of Rights are not effectively being taught in many of our schools, or with the illegal aliens that we are allowing to just walk across our border.

"Look it's really important that we get people coming to the United States of America that love this country, and that want to be a part of this country. Look at me. I came to make, not take; to give, not receive; to join the place, not complain about it or change it. And they're the kind of people that we need if we are going to make sure that this is an American century and that this remains the exceptional nation on the earth." —Nick Adams

Lessons in History: American Exceptionalism

"I am afraid that people are losing sight of how different, unique, and exceptional our country is.

In the 1960s we had radical social movements that were taking place and they were serious. The Black Panthers had one individual who was very famous, his name was Eldridge Cleaver. He stood up with his fist and he proclaimed you know how evil America was, and how racist it was. Then, he committed a crime went to prison. When he was released from prison, he went to Cuba. I met him after he got back from Cuba. He was a completely changed man. He realized what a great system America had. And instead of looking for what was wrong with it, he said he should have been looking for what was right with it and build on it.



So that was a homegrown American, that had to be taken outside the country to see what the difference is.

What I fear now is we're bringing in a whole batch of immigrants that never get the opportunity to learn about the greatness of America and the immigrants are only being told how bad we are and what's wrong with America because immigration has been politicized..." -Kevin Freeman

2. The importance of vetting and a true US immigration policy.

- We are seeing the politicization of immigration.
- We're bringing in thousands, if not millions of people who really aren't receiving any kind of vetting.
- Democrats are saying if you are here illegally, it is alright. You should have open borders, and anyone can come here anytime.

"If China realized they could send as many people as they wanted, and they could vote and control the election what would they do?" –Kevin Freeman

- Our current US immigration policy is not acting in the best interest of our country
- The left does not want the best people coming here. Many politicians want to turn the US into Europe.
- European socialism in the US will lead to Americans losing their passion. There will be fewer dreams, inventions, and innovation.

"US immigration needs to support people coming to the United States of America who are going to contribute. People willing to learn how to speak English and ready to be an integral part of society. They should not be coming to the US to just recreate their homeland in a new stretch of land. They're going to see America as an idea, as an ideology, as a set of values, as a land of opportunity that they want to embrace. The United States of America is the best place in the world to start a business and to grow business. (Summary points from Nick Adams)




- a. That's because there's virtually no red tape relatively speaking compared to Australia or a European nation.

Nick Adams went into 42 public schools in 2016 and was alarmed to find out that our young people had virtually no knowledge, even basic knowledge, of the United States Constitution, the Declaration of Independence, or the Federalist Papers.

In addition, The Foundation for Liberty and American Greatness (FLAG) works with schools to get their commitment on three simple things:

- **Number one**, display an American flag in every classroom.
- **Number two**, recite the Pledge of Allegiance every day.
- And **number three**, sing the national anthem before all major sporting events.

As of this posting, 4,257 schools signed up to that commitment.
