Know Your Elbert County Citizens Facebook Instigators (aka Moderators)

Current:	Jill Duvall	Registered and active Democrat. Former Democrat County Party Chair. Twice failed (2012/16) Democrat Candidate for Commissioner. Spouse of Current Democrat County Party Chair and failed (2010) Democrat Candidate for Assessor. Active member of the anti-Trump High Plains Indivisibles. Backer in several lawsuits filed against the county.	
	John Dorman	John Dorman - Currently registered Republican. Left party to unsuccessfully run for Commissioner in 2014 as "Unaffiliated". Re-registered as Republican after loss. Party in past lawsuit against County. Active in the anti-Trump High Plains Indivisibles.	
	Jane Penley	Currently registered Republican. Left party to unsuccessfully run for Assessor in 2014. Reregistered as republican after loss. Erroneously claims to be a "life-long republican" Advocates support for Democrats. Former active member of the "High Plains Indivisibles. Frequently observed "liking" Democrat candidate posts. Prominently displayed a "Republicans for Jill Duvall" sign on her property in the 2016 elections.	
Former:	Jay Thomas	A Mystery. Jill Duvall claimed he was an "Unaffiliated" Elbert County Voter - though there is none by his name registered. His profile picture is that of former Supreme Court Justice Rehnquist. Rehnquist was a strong Republican who voted against Roe v. Wade. A scroll through "Jay's" public Facebook page reveals almost exclusive anti-GOP and never-Trump posts.	
	Marlene Groves	Established the Elbert County Citizens Facebook site during 2016 election. Publicly critical of county party and elected officials on social media and column in local newspaper. Recently advocated for the appointment of Democrats and parties who sue the county to county boards.
