

# ELBERT COUNTY ELECTION INFORMATION

**Did you get your ballot?** Ballots were mailed out on Friday, October 9. They should arrive around the 13<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup>. Once complete, we recommend putting them directly in one of the three secure 24-Hour Drop Boxes that will be open until 7pm on election night, November 3.

## BY MAIL

**Apply adequate postage to your return envelope. Mail by October 26 to ensure enough time for delivery. POST MARKS DO NOT COUNT!!** By law, Colorado ballots must be in the hands of the Clerk and Recorder by 7:00pm on Nov. 3. Other states have different rules, but Colorado is clear. **POST MARKS DON'T COUNT.**

**TRACK YOUR BALLOT:** Once you've voted, you can check to see where your ballot is in the process. Go to [govotecolorado.gov](http://govotecolorado.gov) and scroll down to "check my ballot status." You will need your name, zip code and date of birth. If you check and do not see that your ballot has been counted, call the Clerk's office. They can check further for you and/or have you fill out a new ballot- if the other one turns up, it won't be counted.

**VOTER REGISTRATION:** Visit [www.GoVoteColorado.gov](http://www.GoVoteColorado.gov) to register to vote up to election day. Find your existing registration, make changes, download forms, view the status of your ballot, & more. ..

**BALLOT PICK-UP:** If you cannot deliver your ballot in person, Ron Turner, a member of the EC Republican Central Committee can be contacted to arrange a pick-up. Colorado law allows for any one person to hand deliver ballots from nine other voters plus their own for a total of 10. Its commonly referred to as "ballot harvesting" but the 10 limit is legal in Colorado. So please check with any of your neighbors, friends and relatives who might need your help with this.
