Environment Hamilton made during
our Board of Health delegation in
Spring 2019**

We urge the City of Hamilton to:

Revisit and update its greenhouse gas emission reduction targets in light of the new understanding in the October 2018 IPCC report.

Commit to annual targets and reporting on greenhouse gas emissions in the City.

Commit to applying a climate lens to all decisions made by the municipality.

Direct the City Manager to instruct all senior staff to mandate the use of this lens across all city departments.

Commit more city staff and more staff time to analysis and implementation using this lens.

We must start and continue with actions that transition Hamilton to a post-carbon society.

**Focus growth within the
existing urban boundary.**

**Develop and implement a Hamilton
"Green Standard" for new public & private
buildings.**

Invest in and enhance green infrastructure.

**Expand and improve public transit -
our communities are not complete without it.**

Invest in and generate renewable energy.

Implement a fair stormwater fee.

**Implement the Home Energy Retrofit
Opportunity (HERO) program.**
