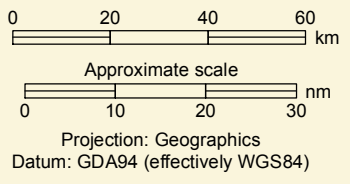
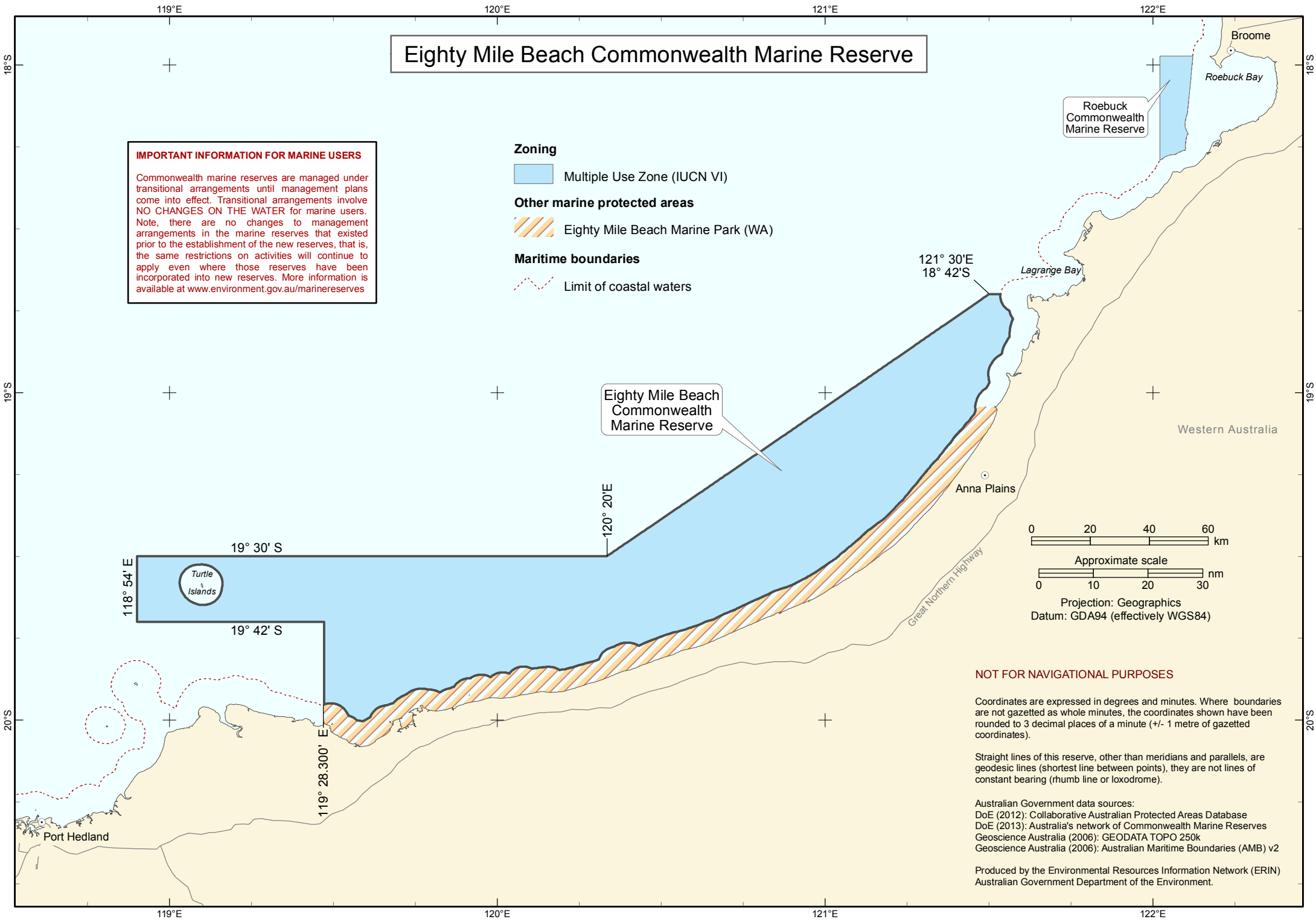


# Eighty Mile Beach Commonwealth Marine Reserve

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR MARINE USERS**

Commonwealth marine reserves are managed under transitional arrangements until management plans come into effect. Transitional arrangements involve **NO CHANGES ON THE WATER** for marine users. Note, there are no changes to management arrangements in the marine reserves that existed prior to the establishment of the new reserves, that is, the same restrictions on activities will continue to apply even where those reserves have been incorporated into new reserves. Coordinates are expressed in degrees and minutes. Where boundaries are not gazetted as whole minutes, the coordinates shown have been rounded to 3 decimal places of a minute (+/- 1 metre of gazetted coordinates).

Straight lines of this reserve, other than meridians and parallels, are geodesic lines (shortest line between points), they are not lines of constant bearing (rhumb line or loxodrome).
