The PCN was established in 2005 to widen the leadership pipeline and create opportunities for skills development and personal growth of young people of color in foundations and other philanthropic institutions. Since its inception, EPIP's PCN has engaged 100+ young leaders from a diverse range of institutions, geographic locations, backgrounds and roles within the philanthropic field.

PCN is specifically intended to support young people of color in the field, such as Asian American, African American, Native American, Native Hawaiian and Pacific Islander, Latin American, or multiracial individuals. This reflects EPIP's emphasis on ensuring racial diversity within our next-generation work.

The PCN offers participants access to professional development training and intergenerational learning opportunities, with the intent of diversifying and retaining people of color within the sector.

The content of the PCN gathering itself is three-fold:

- 1) making personal connections to social justice work;
- 2) understanding structural racism; and
- 3) bringing this work back home.

This year's PCN gathering is open to all: people of color and their white allies.
