Note 1: Accounting Policies "How did we do our accounting"

Basis of Preparation

Engineers Without Borders New Zealand Inc is permitted by law to apply PBE SFR-C (NFP) Public Benefit Entity Simple Format Reporting - Cash (Not-For-Profit) and has elected to do so. All transactions are reported in the Statement of Receipts and Payments and related Notes to the Performance Report on a cash basis.

Goods and Services Tax (GST)

Engineers Without Borders New Zealand Inc is registered for GST. Therefore amounts recorded in the Performance Report are exclusive of GST (if any). GST owing, or GST refunds due as at balance date are shown in the Statement of Resources and Commitments.

Funding received from the New Zealand Aid Programme

Engineers Without Borders New Zealand Inc received funding during the 2019 year from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade through the New Zealand Aid Programe. A Grant of \$66,730 (excl GST) was received for the Technical Support for the Water Sector Partnership in Kiribati, and a Grant of \$160,000 (excl GST) was received for the Tarawa Solar Distillation Water Supply Pilot in Vanuatu.

Related Party Transactions

Engineers Without Borders New Zealand Inc had no related party transactions requiring disclosure in the Financial Year (2018 nil).

Events after the Balance Date

Engineers Without Borders New Zealand Inc has no events occuring after Balance Date that would affect the Financial Statements.

AUDITOR'S REPORT

We have audited the financial statements of Engineers Without Borders New Zealand Inc set out on pages 1 to 6, comprising Entity Information, a Statement of Service Performance, a Statement of Receipts and Payments, Statement of Resources and Committments and Notes To The Performance Report, in accordance with accepted auditing standards, and have carried out such procedures as we have considered necessary. The financial report provides information about the past financial performance of Engineers Without Borders New Zealand Inc and its financial position at 31 December 2019

The Organisation's Responsibilities:

The Board of Engineers Without Borders New Zealand Inc is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting practice in New Zealand and for such internal control as the Board determines is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibilities:

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with International Standards of Auditing (New Zealand). Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgement, including the assessment of the risk of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis of our audit opinion.

Other than in our capacity as auditor we have no relationship with, or interest in Engineers Without Borders New Zealand Inc.

Qualified Opinion:

In common with other organisations of a similar nature, control of income from donations prior to its being recorded is limited, and there are no practical audit procedures to determine the effect of this limited control.

Subject to the possible effect of the limited controls referred to above, in our opinion, the financial statements set out on pages 1 to 6 give a true and fair view of the financial position of Engineers Without Borders New Zealand Inc as at 31 December 2019 and its financial performance for the year then ended in accordance with generally accepted accounting practice in New Zealand.
