



Advocates release open letter about concerns with the Good Society website

In response to questioning from Labor Senator Louise Pratt during Education and Employment Committee Senate Estimates today, Minister Linda Reynolds challenged Senator Pratt to provide a specific list of concerning elements of the Good Society website (as part of the Respect Matters program) which remains online.

Fair Agenda and End Rape on Campus Australia have released an open letter containing a list of specific concerns they have already identified.

The questioning of Department of Education bureaucrats today was focused on what sort of expert advice had been sought and who had approved the widely discredited milkshake consent video released as part of the website (And removed less than a week later) by the Government in April.
