RepresentWomen advocates for institutional reforms that level the playing field for women candidates. These reforms include political party recruitment targets, PAC gender targets, fairer voting systems, and legislative norms that enable women to lead effectively.

Women are underrepresented at every level of the government, while the rate of increase in women's representation overall has stagnated. As a result, the U.S. now ranks behind 103 nations for women's political representation at the national level.

At the current rate of change, it will take many, many centuries to achieve gender parity in elected office. We cannot wait that long for an equal voice in government.

It's time for the U.S. to adopt systemic reforms that have advanced women's representation around the globe.

What Can You Do?



- Establish Gender Parity Task Forces to assess the status of women's representation
- Challenge your political party to set recruitment targets for women candidates
- Meet with PACs and other groups of which you are a member to set targets for intentional action in endorsements and political giving



- Mobilize! Advocate for adopting ranked choice voting (RCV) in your town, county, or state
- Find an RCV advocacy group in your community. Don't have one? Start one!
- Call or write to your elected officials and tell them to support the Fair Representation Act in Congress



- Advocate for just internal practices within government that enable women to serve effectively (ex. childcare, fairer leadership selection processes, etc.)
- Challenge gatekeepers at the city, state, and federal level to appoint women to key leadership positions (ex. committee chair)
