**Notice of Compliance Audit Committee meeting Monday April 29, 2019.**

On April 1, 2019 the Clerk received an Application for Compliance Audit from Evan Balgord for the Candidate Faith Goldy.

The Municipal Elections Act, 1996, provides that the Compliance Audit Committee shall consider the application and decide whether it should be granted or rejected within 30 days after receiving the application.

Should you wish to respond to the Application, you may do so in writing to the Clerk at your earliest convenience, a minimum of three business days prior to the Committee meeting. The Clerk will distribute to Committee members any written submissions, including those of a Candidate or Applicant, in relation to the Application or other item on an agenda.

At the meeting, any persons present for the item who have registered with the Clerk may address the Committee. An Applicant, Candidate or their agent will be given sufficient time to address the application. A person who is not an Applicant, Candidate or their agent may speak to the item for up to 5 minutes. If either party fails to attend the meeting the Committee may proceed in the party's absence and the party will not be entitled to further notice in relation to the meeting or subsequent meetings at which the Application is considered.



She solicited donations of any amount from anywhere to support this lawsuit in contravention of the Municipal Elections Act: "I'm accepting donations from supporters of democracy WORLDWIDE." She confirms money intended for the lawsuit was collected by her campaign. Given the above we have little confidence that her income in this time period, much of which comes from supporters outside Ontario, was kept separate from campaign donations.  Goldy accepted payments on her campaign website and to a gmail account. Since the candidate is accepting donations by e-transfer, we believe their personal bank account should also be captured by a compliance audit to determine whether funds intended for their campaign are being used as intended and properly recorded separately from her income at the time.  I believe on reasonable grounds that the candidate or registered third party noted above has contravened a provision of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, relating to election campaign finances.
