

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING

(Notice Published on July 28, 2017)

The Department of Justice (Department or DOJ) proposes to amend section 4002 of Title 11, Division 5, of the California Code of Regulations (CCR) after considering all comments, objections, and recommendations regarding the proposed action.

PUBLIC HEARING

The Department will hold a public hearing to receive public comments on the proposed regulatory action at 1:00 p.m. - 3:00 p.m. on September 12, 2017, at the location listed below:

AUTHORITY AND REFERENCE

Authority: Penal Code sections 27560, 27565, 27875, 27920, 27966, 28000, 28230 and 28240.

INFORMATIVE DIGEST/POLICY STATEMENT OVERVIEW

Existing Laws and Regulations

California Penal Code (PC) sections 27560, 27565, 27875, 27920, 27966, 28000, 28230 and 28240 authorize the Department to charge fees for processing various firearms reports regarding the acquisition and ownership of firearms. Section 4002 of Title 11, Division 5, Chapter 1, of the California Code of Regulations (CCR) specify the fees and establish the forms for these firearms reports. California Civil Code section 1798.17 requires a privacy notice, regarding the collection and use of personal information, to be provided "... on or with any form used to collect personal information from individuals...."

Effect of the Proposed Rulemaking

The proposed rulemaking will amend section 4002 for the sole purpose of updating the revision dates of Bureau of Firearms forms to correspond with the addition of a privacy notice to each form. It should be noted that the information required on each of the forms, as previously established via incorporation by reference, is not being changed by this rulemaking activity.

ANTICIPATED BENEFITS OF THE PROPOSED REGULATIONS

Adding a privacy notice to Bureau of Firearms forms that require personal information will make the Department compliant with Civil Code section 1798.17. Moreover, the addition of the privacy notice benefits California residents by providing the following information regarding the collection and use of their personal identification as required pursuant to California Civil Code section 1798.17:

- The name of the agency and the division within the agency requesting the information.
- The title, business address, and telephone number of the agency official who is responsible for the system of records and who shall, upon request, inform an individual regarding the location of his or her records and the categories of any persons who use the information in those records.
- The authority that authorizes the maintenance of the information.
- With respect to each item of information, whether submission of such information is mandatory or voluntary.
- The consequences of not providing all or any part of the requested information.
- The principal purpose or purposes for which the information is to be used.
- Any known or foreseeable disclosures which may be made of the information pursuant to subdivision (e) or (f) of Civil Code section 1798.24.
- The individual's right of access to records containing personal information which are maintained by the agency.

EVALUATION OF INCONSISTENCY/INCOMPATIBILITY WITH EXISTING REGULATIONS

The Department has determined that the proposed amendment is not inconsistent or incompatible with existing regulations. After conducting a review for any existing regulations that would

relate to or affect this subject matter, the Department has concluded that these are the only regulations that concern Bureau of Firearms forms to which a privacy notice is being added.

Small Business Determination

The Department has determined the proposed regulations will not affect small business. This determination is based on the proposed regulations merely adding a privacy notice to Bureau of Firearms forms as required pursuant to California Civil Code section 1798.17. The privacy notice provides information regarding the collection and use of personal identification and does not affect small business.

CONSIDERATION OF ALTERNATIVES

In accordance with Government Code section 11346.5, subdivision (a)(13), the Department must determine that no reasonable alternative it considered, or that has otherwise been identified and brought to the attention of the Department, would be more effective in carrying out the purpose for which the action is proposed, would be as effective and less burdensome to affected private persons than the proposed action, or would be more cost effective to affected private persons and equally effective in implementing the statutory policy or other provision of law.

Any person interested in presenting statements or arguments with respect to alternatives to the proposed regulations may do so at the scheduled hearing or during the written comment period.

INITIAL STATEMENT OF REASONS

PROBLEM STATEMENT

California Civil Code section 1798.17 requires a privacy notice, regarding the collection and use of personal information, to be provided "... on or with any form used to collect personal information from individuals...." The Department of Justice (Department) is adding a privacy notice to five forms and updating the revision dates of those forms as referenced in Title 11, Section 4002, of the California Code of Regulations.

BENEFITS

The addition of the privacy notice benefits the general public by providing the following information as required pursuant to California Civil Code section 1798.17:

- The name of the agency and the division within the agency requesting the information.
- The title, business address, and telephone number of the agency official who is responsible for the system of records and who shall, upon request, inform an individual regarding the location of his or her records and the categories of any persons who use the information in those records.
- The authority that authorizes the maintenance of the information.
- With respect to each item of information, whether submission of such information is mandatory or voluntary.
- The consequences of not providing all or any part of the requested information.
- The principal purpose or purposes for which the information is to be used.
- Any known or foreseeable disclosures which may be made of the information pursuant to subdivision (e) or (f) of Civil Code section 1798.24.
- The individual's right of access to records containing personal information which are maintained by the agency.

PURPOSE AND NECESSITY

§ 4002

This section is amended for the sole purpose of updating the revision dates of the five forms referenced in this section to correspond with the addition of privacy notices. It should be noted that the information required on each of the forms, as previously established via incorporation by reference, is not being changed by this rulemaking activity.

The addition of the privacy notice to forms that require submission of personal information is necessary for the Department to comply with Civil Code section 1798.17.

TECHNICAL, THEORETICAL, AND/OR EMPIRICAL STUDY, REPORT OR DOCUMENTS

The Department did not rely upon any technical, theoretical, or empirical studies, reports, or documents in proposing the adoption of the regulations in this rulemaking.

RESULTS OF THE ECONOMIC IMPACT ASSESSMENT

The Department has concluded the proposed regulations will not affect (1) the creation or elimination of jobs within California, (2) the creation of new businesses or the elimination of existing businesses within California, (3) the expansion of businesses currently doing business within California. This conclusion is based on the proposed regulations merely updating the revision date on five forms due to the addition of a privacy notice. There are no fees or costs associated with the privacy notice.

As detailed above, the proposed regulations will benefit the general public by providing notice regarding the collection and use of personal information including an individual's right of access to records maintained by the Bureau of Firearms that contain that individual's personal information.

EVIDENCE SUPPORTING FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT STATEWIDE ADVERSE ECONOMIC IMPACT DIRECTLY AFFECTING BUSINESS

The Department has determined that the proposed regulations will not have a significant, statewide, adverse economic impact affecting business because the forms referenced in the proposed regulations are used only by individuals rather than businesses.

REASONABLE ALTERNATIVES TO THE REGULATIONS AND THE DEPARTMENT'S REASONS FOR REJECTING THOSE ALTERNATIVES

No reasonable alternatives to the regulations were presented to or considered by the Department that would be either more effective in carrying out the purpose for which the action is proposed, or would be as effective and less burdensome.

Collector In-State Acquisition of Curio or Relic Long Gun Report Requirements

Federally licensed collectors (FFL type 03) in California who have a current COE may acquire curio or relic long guns from non-licensees without completing the transfer through a licensed firearms dealer only if he/she completes and submits this report to the California Department of Justice within thirty (30) days of taking possession of the long gun. Your failure to comply with this reporting requirement could result in criminal prosecution. (Pen. Code, §§ 27590 & 27966)

Pursuant to Penal Code section 28230, subdivision (a)(3), you must submit this application along with a \$19.00 processing fee (check or money order made payable to the Department of Justice) to:

Please note, incomplete applications or applications submitted without the proper fees will be returned without processing. If reporting more than three firearms, attach additional copies of this form as needed. A firearms eligibility check will be conducted to determine whether you are lawfully eligible to possess firearms. Once approved, you will receive a confirmation notice of your Collector In-State Acquisition of Curio or Relic Long Gun Report.

This form may not be used to report ownership of assault weapons defined in Penal Code sections 30510 through 30530. It is the responsibility of the applicant to determine if the firearm being reported is an assault weapon. A list of assault weapons is available on the Bureau of Firearms website at www.oag.ca.gov/firearms.

Part A. Owner Information

Enter the information as requested. Only one applicant per form.

Part B. Long Gun Information

For each long gun, you must provide the identification information requested. Please refer to your long gun owner's manual, the long gun manufacturer's website, or the examples below to assist you in providing the required information:

- Long Gun Type: Rifle or Shotgun
- Category: Bolt Action, Lever Action, Pump Action, Revolver, Semi-Automatic, or Single Shot
- Serial Number: Usually located on the receiver of a long gun. May be all numeric or a combination of alpha and numeric characters. (e.g., 98765, US54321G)
- Make: The manufacturer of the long gun. (e.g., Remington, Winchester, Smith & Wesson)
- Model: The model name of the long gun. (e.g., 870 Express, Model 70, M&P 15)
- Caliber: The caliber of the long gun. (e.g., 12 gauge, .308 Winchester, .223 Remington)
- Long Gun Origin: The country of origin of the long gun. (e.g., United States, Russia, China, Italy)
- Barrel Length: Enter the barrel length as stated either in your owner's manual, manufacturer's website, or measure the barrel length by closing the action of the firearm and inserting a wooden dowel down the barrel until it stops. Mark the dowel with a pen at the muzzle. Remove the dowel and measure the distance between the inserted end of the dowel and the pen mark.

The information you provide may also be disclosed in the following circumstances:

- With other persons or agencies where necessary to perform their legal duties, and their use of your information is compatible and complies with state law, such as for investigations or for licensing, certification, or regulatory purposes;
- To another government agency as required by state or federal law.
