On behalf of our members, supporters, and all law-abiding Californians, Firearms Policy Coalition respectfully submits our **OPPOSITION** to Senator Wiener's SB 281.

SB281 prohibits the sale of firearms and ammunition at the Cow Palace located in District 1-A.

Despite years of hosting gun shows with no reported incidents and no reported firearms sold at the event being used in the commission of any crime, this event is always the target of a shut down.

SB 281 is a direct attempt to deprive the residents of San Francisco and the surrounding areas of their Second Amendment Rights. **For these and other reasons, FPC requests your "NO" vote on SB 281.**
