**Assembly Bill 1669 "AB 1669" (Bonta)**

**Position: OPPOSE**

- This bill is an extension of the grotesque initiative known as Proposition 63 that was voted on a few years ago. For the same principles in which we vehemently **OPPOSED** Prop. 63, so do we also **OPPOSE** in AB 1669.
- The bill would legislate that “any ammunition carried onto the premises of a gun show or event by members of the public shall be checked and secured in a manner that prevents the ammunition from being discharged”.
- This regulation is ridiculous because it is already codified that all firearms “carried onto the premises of a gun show or event by members of the public shall be checked, cleared of any ammunition, secured in a manner that prevents them from being operated, and an identification tag or sticker shall be attached to the firearm, prior to the person being allowed admittance to the show”.
- How would someone discharge ammunition without the proper firearm? Are people going to terrorize gun shows by throwing bullets from their hand? Or perhaps the ammunition will be discharged via a slingshot? This is simply an unnecessary regulation.
