Before the 2017 Legislative Session, 6 proposed MMJ Bills contained some of the following

After failing to pass a MMJ bill in Regular Session, FFC pushed for a special session and helped pass SB-8A with:

90 Day Wait

90 Day wait periods for patients

0 Day Wait

0 Day wait period for sick patients

No Research

No research, no independent laboratory testing, no food safety standards

Research + Testing

Research funding, Independent Laboratory testing, and Food Safety/dosing standards

No Retail Regulations

No retail regs - Unlimited retail possible by schools OR Extremely limited retail

Retail Regulations

25 Retail per MMTC to start, distributed in 5 regions, must be 500 ft. from schools + must be treated the same as pharmacies

7 MMTC's

ONLY 7 MMTC licensees total statewide

17 MMTC's by Oct. '17

+ 4 More MMTC w/ 5 more retail per 100K Patients, with 500K patients 37 MMTC total

No options

No vaporizing, edibles, or flower available

Options

Vaporizing and edibles w/ proper packaging and flower available sealed for vaping

90-day Supply

No more than a 90 Day Supply

210-day Supply

210 Day supply (3-70 day supply), revisit every 30 weeks

No Education Funding

No appropriate funding (3 DOH Staff etc.)

Education Funding

55 additional DOH Jobs, \$500K Education, \$5 Mill Highway Safety, \$100K Train LE & More

8-Hours

8 Hour Doctor course

2-Hours

2 Hour Doctor course

No on Pain

No chronic pain language

Yes on Pain

Chronic pain language added

No Out-of-State

No out of state patients allowed
