I'm writing to you as a parent and your constituent, concerned that Bill C-12, *Canada's Net Zero Emissions Accountability Act* is being held up and is in danger of not making it through Third Reading and Senate review. This is unacceptable.

I'm also contacting you on behalf of the many parents who share my concern but may be silent for many reasons.

Bill C-12 isn't perfect. We don't need perfect right now; we need legislation that will get us on a path and in the right direction. We also don't need to waste more time on political tactics. This bill needs to become law before the summer recess.

Will you commit to working with your colleagues across party lines to ensure that Bill C-12 does not get stalled at the House of Commons?

This is one of the most important pieces of legislation before the House. It sets out how we will deal with the existential issue of our time, and what future generations will face. It goes beyond party politics, and it requires political and personal courage to succeed.

As my elected representative at the federal level, you've been responsible for leading Canada through the Covid-19 crisis by focusing on the health and well-being of Canadians. I'm urging you to act equally courageously to lead us through the climate crisis.

This is an existential crisis that reaches beyond party lines; at times like these, Canadians expect their leaders to work together and get immediate action. We are in the most decisive decade in human history, and you have a chance to pass a climate accountability act that will give children and future generations a fighting chance for a liveable future. Please do not let this crucial opportunity be lost.
