

Health Care Must Haves

- 1. Coverage must be universal, affordable, and include all essential health benefits guaranteed by the Affordable Care Act (listed below)
- 2. No one can be denied coverage due to pre-existing conditions
- 3. No lifetime bans on coverage
- 4. Coverage must include all reproductive care, including but not limited to contraception, pre and post natal care, and abortion care
- 5. No one can be charged more based solely on sex, age, race, religion, sexual orientation or gender expression
- 6. Education component that includes wellness and prevention training

Essential Health Benefits

- Ambulatory patient services (outpatient care you get without being admitted to a hospital)
- Emergency services
- Hospitalization (like surgery and overnight stays)
- Pregnancy, maternity, and newborn care (both before and after birth)
- Mental health and substance use disorder services, including behavioral healthtreatment (this includes counseling and psychotherapy)
- Prescription drugs
- Rehabilitative and habilitative services and devices (services and devices to help people with injuries, disabilities, or chronic conditions gain or recover mental and physical skills)
- Laboratory services
- Preventive and wellness services and chronic disease management
- Pediatric services, including oral and vision care (but adult dental and vision coverage aren't essential health benefits)
