Because I believe in informed decision making, I want to share platform details with you.

Environment & Green Space

- Accelerate replacement of the EDPA through a Mayor's Standing Committee on biodiversity
- Draw upon best practices in other jurisdictions, and Diamond Head report recommendations
- Include Saanich Parks
- Provide incentives for private property
- Protect urban green space
- Protect Urban Containment Boundary
- Continue park acquisition, eg., Kings Rd. greenspace
- Bring effective solution to tent cities in parks

Local Business

- Support local businesses & Saanich economy
- Expand our commercial tax base
- Grow good, local jobs
- Enable food truck options
- Improve options to work, live and play in Saanich

Farms

- Work with key agencies to enhance farm incomes
- Promote agri-tourism; create seasonal farm worker housing and encourage "buy local"
- Use yard waste and park leaf mulch to improve the quality of our farm lands
- Respect the Agricultural Land Reserve

Amalgamation

I have an open mind and evidence based approach

- On October 20th, you can vote in a ballot to say yes or no to establishing a Citizens' Assembly to examine amalgamating Saanich with Victoria
- I have never been a director of Amalgamation Yes. I have an open mind
- If elected as your Mayor, I will follow the informed decision of Saanich residents
- Regardless of the ballot, I am committed to responsive government, cost effective service delivery, including shared services where beneficial

Housing

- Create a Mayor's Standing Committee to address solutions to the housing crisis
- Encourage varying mixes of housing for all types of individuals, working families, seniors and students
- Gentle, environmentally responsible infill, that respects neighbourhood character, eg, garden suites
- Focus density on transit corridors and in centres
- Encourage more on-campus student housing
- Adopt strategies for new rental housing including improved density on existing rental properties
- Support more co-op housing and assisted housing
- Ensure staff and council have resources to update the Local Area Plans during the coming term

Traffic & Transportation

Transit, traffic and roads need integrated planning

- Change the Victoria Regional Transit Commission to a Transportation Commission. Address road planning, reduce commute times, increase transit ridership, active transport and cut emissions
- Encourage newer choices such as car share co-ops, e-bikes, and rental bikes. Harvest benefits of reduced traffic, parking and congestion
- Take safety actions on priority roads, such as Ash Rd.
- Safe routes to school a priority
- Take action on cut-through truck traffic

Fiscal Accountability

- Respect the taxpayer, live within our means
- Work with council, staff and residents on budget processes to ensure our services are cost effective
- Support opportunities for the public to influence budget decisions
- Continue to set aside funds for long term infrastructure replacement
- Utilize opportunities for shared services
- Pursue more funding opportunities with senior levels of government and private sector
