- 3) Congressional action as of 7/13/17 on the Fiscal Year 2018 budget. As of this date, the below Committees have introduced funding bills, which are consistent with the budget caps, and have seen the following movement:
 - a. The House Appropriations Subcommittee that handles HUD funding has proposed the funding levels noted, approved them, and passed them along to the Full Appropriations Committee.
 - b. The House Appropriations Subcommittee that handles Labor, HHS, and Education funding has introduced and approved a bill, but it does not include detailed funding levels for most of the programs in this chart. The report language has not yet been released. It has been passed along to the Full Appropriations Committee.
 - c. Congress passed VA's advanced FY 2018 appropriation in September, 2016, along with FY 2017 funding for VA programs. The House Appropriations Subcommittee that handles VA funding has introduced and approved a bill that increases the advanced amount for homelessness programs for VA's final FY 2018 appropriation. However, it only includes the overall funding level for VA homelessness programs, as indicated in this chart. It has been approved by the Full Appropriations Committee.
 - d. House Appropriations Subcommittee that handles Department of Homeland Security funding has proposed the funding levels noted, approved them, and passed them along to the Full Appropriations Committee.
