AWARD CATEGORIES:

Outstanding Local Volunteer	Awarded to a local person who has volunteered to support a local charity or cause. This individual demonstrates a selfless commitment to others and goes above and beyond in service to our local community.
Conservation Champion	Awarded to a local person who has dedicated themselves to caring for our natural environment and to promoting conservation.
Young Person in Small Business	Awarded to a local young person (under 30) who operates a small business located in the Kiama electorate.
Small Business	Awarded to a local small business operator located in the Kiama electorate.
Outstanding Emergency Service Volunteer	Awarded to a local volunteer member of the NSW Police, NSW Ambulance, Rural Fire Service, State Emergency Service, Surf Life Saving or Marine Rescue. This person has demonstrated outstanding commitment to serving our community in times of need.
Junior Sports (Male and Female)	Awarded to a local young sportsperson aged under 18. This person has demonstrated strong commitment to their sporting endeavour and represented our region. There is a female and male category for this award.
Local Sports (Male and Female)	Awarded to a local sportsperson aged over 18. This person has demonstrated strong commitment to their sporting endeavour and represented our region. There is a female and male category for this award.
Sports Administrator	Awarded to an administrator/ volunteer with a local sporting club. This person has demonstrated outstanding commitment to assisting with the administration of a sporting club, team or event.
Outstanding Young Citizen	Awarded to a young person (under 25) who has made an enormous contribution to our local community across a range of different endeavours and categories. This person exemplifies the values of citizenship, leadership and giving back to our community.
Outstanding Citizen	Awarded to an individual who has made an enormous contribution to our local community across a range of different endeavours and categories. This person exemplifies the values of citizenship, leadership and giving back to our community.
