



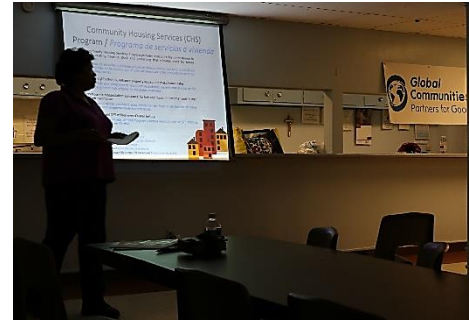
Floreciente Community Meeting
