- Support workfare and zero hours contracts that undermine rights at work.
- They think Health and Safety in the workplace is 'red tape'.

LABOUR WILL:

Scrap loopholes that let employers exploit agency workers (getting rid of the Swedish derogation for those who like technical terms).

Sort out the employment tribunal system because the Tory plan of fees for justice is unfair and simply doesn't work.

Make sure we have decent health and safety protections for working people

Look at ways to ensure proper facility time for union representatives;

Flexible working for parents, and support for grandparents to fit care of their grandchildren around work;

End exploitative zero hours contracts that stop people from being able to plan their lives and stand up for themselves at work.

THIS GOVERNMENT

- Record youth unemployment
- Growth of zero hours contracts

For the first time in history, the majority who of people who live in poverty live in a working household.

Millions want more hours but can't get them 'Workfare' means people are forced to work for free, undermining paid jobs.

AND UNDER LABOUR...

Every firm that gets a big government contract must offer quality apprenticeship places.

Invest in new industry to create decent, skilled jobs and training opportunities.

Bring in a Youth Guarantee so that every young person has a guaranteed job.

Any firm that employs a migrant worker must create a apprenticeship for a Brit.

UNDER THIS GOVERNMENT:

- Wages have gone down while bills and housing costs have gone up
- Nearly a million people used a food bank to feed themselves and their family last year.

LABOUR WILL:

Deliver 25 hours of free childcare for working parents with 3 and 4 year olds, paid for with an increase in the bank levy;

Scrap the bedroom tax;

Freeze energy bills until 2017 and reform the broken energy market;

Introduce a strict cap on rail fare increases so prices won't continue to sky rocket.

WAGES UNDER THE COALITION



WAGES

For the first time ever, the majority of those in poverty are in a working household.

Families are £1,600 worse off on average than in 2010 and wages for £2,500.

Work more for less under a Tory government!

CHANGE UNDER LABOUR

Increase the Minimum Wage and link it to earnings (which is a good thing!)

Use public contracts to promote a Living Wage

Stop employers using loopholes in the law which allow them to exploit migrant workers to undercut terms, pay and conditions.

Ambulance queues have doubled in the last three years.




Waiting lists are at their longest for five years, operations are being rationed and struggling to see their GP.

UNDER LABOUR:



Scrap the Tories' Health & Social Care Act.

Guarantee a GP appointment within 48 hours – and on the same day for those who need it.

By the next election no one will wait more than 7 days for cancer test results.


