LOCAL GOVERNMENT PAY UP-DATE

Local Government Workers should have seen their pay uplifted earlier this year as the local government pay offer was implemented across England, Wales and Northern Ireland. (Full details of the pay uplifts are listed on the right hand side of this newsletter).

The offer was over two years. GMB is now working across the Local Authorities and Local Government Employers to start a discussion on the Year 2 of the pay offer.

As a re-cap part of the two year pay settlement included the introduction of a new pay spine in April 2019. Discussions have started with your union reps and employers. It's important you understand what the new pay spine means to you. GMB has set up a technical working group to assist regions in this vital piece of work. GMB is also organising meetings to discuss how your employer will move you and your colleagues on to the new pay spine. A FAQ has also been agreed with the LGA. What happens in April 2019 & what is the new pay spine?

The NJC pay agreement for 2018-20 includes the introduction of a new pay spine on 1 April 2019 that is based on the following:

- A bottom rate of £9.00 per hour (£17,364) on new Spinal Column Point (SCP)1 (equivalent to old SCPs 6 & 7)
- 'Pairing off' old SCPs 6-17 incl. to create new SCPs 1-6 incl.
- Equal steps of 2.0% between each new SCPs 1 to 22 incl (equivalent to old scpS 6-28 incl.)
- By creating equal steps between these pay points, new SCPs 10, 13, 16, 18 and 21 are generated to which no old SCPs will assimilate. This means that in some organisations the current number of pay points in a grade might change
- On new SCPs 23 and above (equivalent to old SCPs 29 and above), 2.0% increase on 2018 rate.

The local government offer includes a two-year pay increase from 1 April 2018.

The three key features of the offer is worth 5.6% on the pay bill over two years:

- 1) The majority of staff those on salaries starting at £19,430 per annum would receive an uplift of 2% on 1 April 2018 and a further 2% on 1 April 2019.
- 2) Staff on the bottom of the national joint pay spine (Spine Column Point 6 19) will receive higher increases than 2%. In year 1 this ranges between 3.7% 9.3% and then in Year 2 this ranges between 2.6% 5.9%. The starting rate will move to £8.50 on 1 April 2018 (9.1%increase) and will further move to £9.00 on 1 April 2019 (5.9% increase). Almost a third of workers will receive an inflation linked pay rise in year 1.
- 3) The offer also includes the introduction of a new national pay spine on 1 April 2019. If you took part in the GMB pay ballot the above pay rates should apply. If you are unsure about whether your employer follows NJC, get in touch with your local GMB office.
