Duties & Responsibilities

As a Maintenance Process Specialist, you will:

- You will work as part of a shift team controlling and monitoring plant via a Distributed Control System (DCS), carrying out manual tasks such as raw material additions, sampling, in process testing and packing
- You will provide reactive maintenance support to the plants and carry out repair work, as appropriate, in accordance with Maintenance Procedures to deliver high plant availability and reliability
- You will work within EHS requirements to ensure safe working systems and practices are followed and to ensure personal compliance with COMAH critical procedures
- You will be responsible for effective verbal and written communication between yourself and other members of the team to ensure precise and appropriate information is available as required
- You will also work with your team to identify opportunities for improvements in departmental performance

The Individual

- You will have qualifications and industrial experience in a craft discipline (Mechanical / E&I) and be prepared to learn how to operate chemical process plant.
- Alternatively, you will be an experienced process plant operator who can demonstrate an interest and ability in maintenance activities and who is prepared to study to gain appropriate maintenance qualifications to a minimum of Level 3
- Two or more years technical and work experience in the chemical industry or related industry
- Ability to fault find process and plant equipment and identify solutions
- You will have an ability to work well with others and independently
- An effective communicator, you will be able to demonstrate the ability to communicate complex information to your shift manager, days team and peers
- You will have the ability to operate computer-based packages and knowledge of EHS requirements for safe working (permit to work, risk assessments, procedures)
- You will hold or have the ability to pass a forklift truck driving test
- The plants on site are multi level with multiple landings, accessed via stairs and ladders. The candidate should be of sufficient physical health to walk and climb stairs, climb ladders, lift up to 20 KG, and, when necessary, use a respiratory mask.
