Duties & Responsibilities

As part of a team in the plant area:

- You will work within EHS requirements to ensure safe working systems and practices are followed, including safe isolation of the plant as instructed, permit risk assessment and maintaining housekeeping standards.
- You will take responsibility for personal actions and the safety of others, ensuring
 personal compliance with all COMAH critical procedures which control the major accident
 hazards in your area.
- You will monitor plant equipment on plant or via the plant control system.
- You will carry out manual tasks including simple maintenance tasks, raw material
 offloading and addition, sampling, in-process testing, packing and transporting materials
 using a forklift truck.
- Through effective teamwork, you will operate and support plant, warehouse, tankfarm and process, including contribution to departmental performance improvements.
- You will maintain a flexible approach to the role as required, to support the business needs of the department, cluster and site as instructed.

- Effective 2-way communication with members of your team, Shift Managers and others is essential including shift handover, recording of key information e.g. logs, simple SAP transactions etc.
