

- 🏠 Didn't get your stimulus checks?
- 👤 Have kids up to age 17?
- ❗ **You have benefits worth thousands of dollars. File a federal tax return by May 17 to get them.**

The three stimulus payments are worth up to **\$3,200 for individuals** and **\$2,500 for children** and other dependents.

Plus, the child tax credit enables you to automatically receive up to **\$300 per month per child**, starting in July. By next year, you could receive up to \$3,600 per child under age 6, and \$3,000 per child age 6-17.

File a federal tax return by May 17 to get these benefits. Need help?

- You can file for free and only need basic information. This can be done via smartphone or computer.
- A permanent address is not required. You can use the address of a friend, family member, shelter, etc.
- You can get these via direct deposit or have a check mailed to you.
- Even if you have a low income, or don't owe income taxes, you can still get this new child tax credit. Only one of the parents with joint custody can claim each child.
