	SCHOOL-BASED P-EBT ROUND 3	KEIKI UNDER 6 FOOD SUPPORT PROGRAM	SUMMER P-EBT
ELIGIBILITY	Student enrolled in free or reduced-price lunch at a Hawaii public, charter or private school that participated in the National School Lunch Program between October 2020 and May 2021	Child under 6 years old received Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) between October 2020 and May 2021. <i>Must have received SNAP in the same month as the P-EBT benefit.</i>	Student enrolled in free or reduced-price school lunch between May 2021 and August 2, 2021 - <i>OR</i> - Child under 6 received SNAP between June 2021 and August 2, 2021.
INCOME LIMITS	All students who attended <u>CEP schools</u> during the 2020-2021 school year qualify. For non-CEP schools, see <u>income limits</u>	SNAP income eligibility standards can be found <u>at this link</u>	See prior columns
CITIZENSHIP	Social security number is NOT required and citizenship status is NOT considered.*	U.S. citizens and some immigrants who are admitted for permanent residency may qualify.*	See prior columns.*
WHAT CAN I BUY WITH P-EBT	*Participation in any P-EBT program will NOT affect immigration or citizenship status. P-EBT benefits can be used to purchase <u>SNAP-eligible foods</u> . P-EBT benefits can be used at food retailers and farmers markets that accept SNAP. Find the retailer nearest you <u>at this link</u> .

BENEFIT DELIVERY METHOD

Existing P-EBT card (from Rounds 1 and 2) or look for a new P-EBT card in the mail.

Kokua EBT card, or Existing P-EBT card if they have already received PEET as students at the DOE/Charter/Private schools.

Existing P-EBT card or Kokua EBT card, or look for a new P-EBT card in the mail.

Starting July 9, apply for free or reduced-price lunch at EZMealApp.com

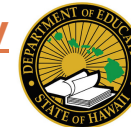
