Glenn Davis is a 44 year old father of three, born and raised in West Philadelphia. A veteran of the U.S. Army, Glenn has also served as the vice-president of Shepard Recreation Advisory Council.



Ending mass incarceration is one of Glenn's main issues. He has been active in Decarcerate PA, a grassroots campaign working to end mass incarceration in Pennsylvania. In 2013 Glenn walked from Philadelphia's Love Park to the Pa. Capitol in Harrisburg to protest the expansion of Graterford Prison in Montgomery County. Glenn wants to reduce the budget of the Bureau of Corrections and increase spending for public education.

Glenn supports a minimum wage of \$15, along with union membership and a 40 hour work week. He has been active in campaigning for a \$15 wage for fast-food workers.

Glenn seeks to raise \$9,245 for his campaign, equivalent to the hourly wage of the CEO of McDonald's Corp.
