- WI Supreme Court Justice

- Milwaukee County Circuit Judges (Judges will be elected for 10 branches, with terms beginning August 1)

April 3, 2018 – Spring General Election

For each office, the candidate with the most votes wins.

August 14, 2018 - Fall Primary

- US Senator
- US Congress Member
- Governor
- Lieutenant Governor
- Attorney General
- Secretary of State
- State Treasurer
- State Assembly Member
- County Clerk of Court
- County Sheriff

You can vote on only one party's list. The winners for each party go on to the November election.

November 6, 2018 – Fall General Election

For each office, the candidate with the most votes wins. (The governor and the lieutenant governor are elected as a team.)

Important Tips for Voters


- ✓ Most people need a photo ID to vote. A WI driver's license or state ID is easiest. Learn if your college ID is OK, how to get a free state ID at the DMV and more at <u>bringit.wi.gov</u>. The Milw. Co. Register of Deeds will give you a free birth certificate (to get a free ID) if you have never had a license or state ID (any state) <u>and</u> were born in and now live in Milwaukee County.
- ✓ If you have trouble getting to the polls because of age, illness, or disability, you can apply for absentee ballots as an **indefinitely confined voter** and you will <u>not</u> need to have ID. Contact City Hall for more info at 414-286-3491.
- ✓ If you move less than 10 days before the election you must vote at your old WI address, in person or absentee.
- ✓ If you have a current valid WI driver's license/state ID you can register to vote or change voting address at myvote.wi.gov until 20 days before election. Otherwise, register at City Hall or at the polls with proof of current address (driver's license/ID, utility bill, government doc, bank statement, etc.).
- At <u>myvote.wi.gov</u> you can find your voting place, see who's on the ballot and check if you are now registered.
