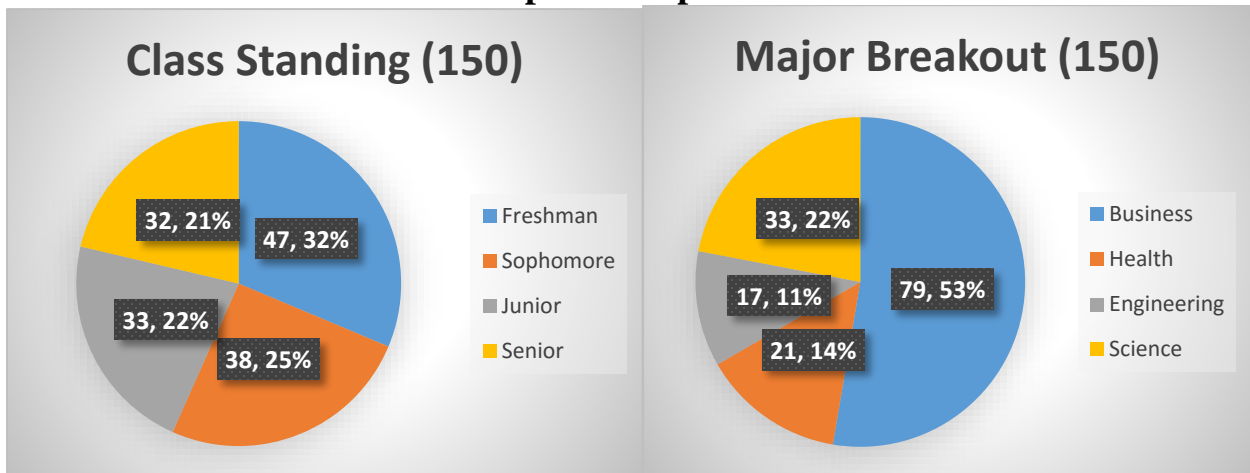
## Chapter Purpose
