**GREENLATINOS ADMONISHES TRUMP ADMINISTRATION FOR SUPPRESSING PUBLIC INPUT AND HALTING ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW OF DAKOTA ACCESS PIPELINE
THE ORGANIZATION REAFFIRMS ITS COMMITMENT TO STAND WITH COMMUNITIES UNDER ATTACK**

WASHINGTON, DC – Yesterday, President Trump’s Administration announced that it will approve a final permit in the controversial Dakota Access Pipeline project without the previously announced and required environmental review. **In reaction to the announcement, GreenLatinos issued the following statement:**

GreenLatinos continues to stand with our partners and friends in the Standing Rock Community against this illegal and reprehensible announcement by the Trump Administration. We support Chairman Archambault and the Sovereign nation of Standing Rock in their defense of clean water for their community.
