If you enter Hinshelwood from South Parks Rd, the School of Geography and the Environment is on the left after about 50m.

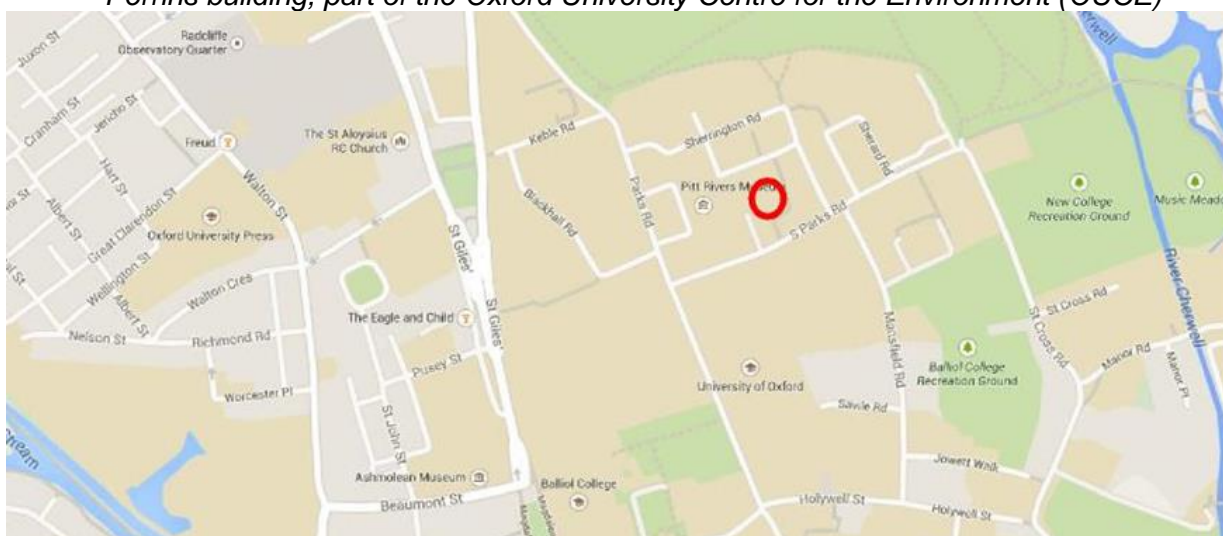
