CONSTITUTION OF THE GREEN PARTY POLITICAL ASSOCIATION OF BRITISH COLUMBIA

(Adopted February, 1983)

(Revised: June 1984, July 1985, July 1988, October 1999, October 2002)

1. The name of the Society is the Green Party Political Association of British Columbia.
2. The purposes of the Society are:
 - a) To carry on the functions of a provincial political party and work towards electing Green Party Members of the Legislative Assembly; and to encourage Members to work towards electing candidates at other levels of government;
 - b) To work towards achieving the goal of nuclear and general disarmament, and world peace through the non-violent resolution of conflict;
 - c) To work towards achieving the goal of a socially just conserver society;
 - d) To work towards an economic system based upon sound ecological principles including the precautionary principle;
 - e) To work towards developing a society that accepts responsibility for and upholds the inalienable rights of all life forms and natural processes that share the earth;
 - f) To develop a community-based democracy with local decision-making and control; and
 - g) To work with urgency on the above stated purposes and undertake all such other activities consistent with these purposes that the Party's Provincial Council consider appropriate.
