How To Fill Out Ballot:

1) Your name

Put your name on the ranking ballot so that if we have a question about your ballot, we can get it back to you for clarification. Also, if you don't put your name your ranking will be discarded.

2) "Needs discussion" column

For *every* proposal (even those you do not rank), fill out this column with a "Yes" or a "No." Enter a "Yes" if you have any questions, concerns, suggestions, etc. Enter a "No" if you think the proposal should be adopted as is. Leaving this column blank is the same as entering a "No."

3) Rank column

Regardless of the number of proposals, start ranking them with 10 points, based on what you think are the top 10 proposals to be addressed at this meeting. Give 10 points to your top choice, 9 to your next choice, and so on down to the least important with 1 point. Do not skip or re-use numbers. Whether you have marked a proposal with a "Yes" or a "No" does not have to influence how you rank your top ten.

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
