



**Congratulations! You are entrusted with the invitation link for the GetUp Action Network Slack!**

*First, let's recap on the purpose and key considerations relating to the GetUp Action Network Slack...*

- Slack allows people in the GetUp Action Network to chat and collaborate with other GetUp members across the country, communicate with their teams, get the latest campaign news and strategy updates, ask staff questions and give feedback.
- Slack is a space for **active members** of Action Groups, people who attend meetings and/or other Action Group events regularly.
- Membership of Slack is about quality, not quantity. It's about making sure we have lots of great and relevant conversations rather than lots of confused people!
- **Slack will be used to share strategic information, so we need to keep it as secure as we can.**

*So, what is this link?*

- It's the link you send to new members of your Action Group to get them on Slack.

*Who has this link?*

- Action Group Coordinators and Secretaries
- State Support Team Members
- GetUp Organising Staff

*How do I use the link?*

- The link is for you to **invite new members** of your Action Group to the GetUp Action Network Slack.
- The link is **never to be published publicly online**. This includes not sharing it on public Slack channels in the GetUp Action Network Slack.
- Please share the link via direct email with new members (example email below).
- When using this link, please always come back to the purpose, ideal membership and privacy considerations relating to the GetUp Action Network Slack- this will help guide how you use the link!

### *Example invitation email*
