



## Earth Day Celebrates 45 Years

Wednesday, April 22, marked the 45th anniversary of Earth Day.

According to the Earth Day Network, organizers of the first event in 1970, more than 1 billion people in 192 countries were expected to participate in Earth Day activities in 2015, making it the largest civic observance in the world.

## Register to Vote

### You are eligible to register to vote if:

- You are a United States citizen;
- You are a resident of the county where you submit the application;
- You are at least 18 years old on Election Day;
- You are not a convicted felon (you may be eligible to vote if you have completed your sentence, probation, and parole); and
- You have not been declared by a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be either totally mentally incapacitated or partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote.

## Eco-Friendly Bird Feeder Instructions

Here's an easy and fun project using common household items to create an eco-friendly bird feeder. You will need:

- Cardboard tube from roll of paper towels or bathroom tissue
- Smooth peanut butter
- Birdseed
- Twig or straw
- String or yarn

Step 1: Make two holes in the tube opposite each other about an inch from one end. Thread string or yarn through the holes to create a loop for hanging.

Step 2: Make two holes opposite each other about two inches from the other end of the tube.

Step 3: Apply an even coat of smooth peanut butter to the tube, covering it from top to bottom.

Step 4: Sprinkle or roll the coated tube in bird seed. Be sure the bird seed covers and sticks all over the peanut butter.

Step 5: Thread a straw or twig through the lower two holes in the tube to form a perch for the birds.

Step 6: Hang the feeder in a place where the birds can find it and enjoy a snack!
