

RESOLUTION TO ENSURE BALLOT SECURITY AND PUBLIC SAFETY

Relative to ballot security, public safety of Georgia drivers' licenses, and President Obama's (multiple illegal) executive (deferred) action on deportation amnesties called "DACA and DAPA" for illegal aliens.

WHEREAS, Despite constitutional requirements for security, American borders have remained intentionally porous since the "one-time" congressional amnesty of 1986;

WHEREAS, (Illegal) employers are the root cause of the crime of illegal immigration and black-market labor which erodes not only the Rule of law upon which our nation was founded, but reduces job prospects and lowers wages for Georgia's struggling workers;

WHEREAS, Ranking seventh in the nation in its population of illegal aliens, Georgia has more illegal (aliens) than Arizona;

WHEREAS, Illegal aliens have benefited and may continue to benefit in the future from President Obama's (illegal regard of) work permits and Social Security Numbers in that they do not have legal status and are still illegal aliens;

WHEREAS, Georgia has been issuing drivers' licenses, official State ID Cards, and public benefits, including unemployment benefits, to illegal aliens who are under deferred action on deportation proceedings since July of 2012;

WHEREAS, The current practice of issuing drivers' licenses to (deferred action) illegal aliens is counter to the intent of decades-old State law designed to make Georgia less attractive to illegal immigration and illegal employment;

WHEREAS, Legislative remedies to State law to halt the ongoing practice of issuing drivers' licenses to illegal aliens are easily accomplished; and

WHEREAS, Multiple other nations in the Americas do not allow illegal aliens to obtain a drivers' license and are currently more enthusiastic in their efforts to battle the crime of illegal immigration than the United States and the State of Georgia; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That State of Georgia Republican Party call upon the Governor of Georgia and the State legislature alter existing law so as to honor its intent to insure that all illegal aliens are prohibited from accessing any type of legal permission to operate any motor vehicle on any public road in our great State;

RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Gwinnett County Republican Party be hereby authorized and directed to transfer a copy of this Resolution to the Gwinnett Republican House and Senate Delegations, The Honorable Casey Cagle, Lieutenant Governor of the State of Georgia, The Honorable Nathan Deal, Governor of the State of Georgia, and the Chairman of the Georgia Republican Party; and be it finally
