INTER-AGENCY ASSISTANCE

UN/SARC/ICRC INTERAGENCY CONVOY ENTERED DUMA ON **5 AND 9 MARCH 2018** WITH FOOD FOR 27,500 PEOPLE, ALONG WITH HEALTH AND NUTRITION SUPPLIES, BUT MANY HEALTH SUPPLIES WERE NOT ALLOWED TO BE LOADED. AUTHORIZATION TO COMPLETE THE DELIVERY FOR ALL **70,000 PEOPLE** IS STILL URGENTLY NEEDED.

PRIOR TO THAT, THE LAST INTERAGENCY CONVOY WAS ON **14 FEBRUARY 2018** WITH FOOD, HEALTH AND NUTRITION SUPPLIES FOR 7,200 PEOPLE TO NASHABIYAH AFTER **78 DAYS OF NO CROSSLINE ACCESS INTO EASTERN GHOUTA.**
