**1. PAC Meeting was called to order by Adam Mehis (E-board Political) at 7:06.**

**2. Save Rincon Park (Tim Hester)**

- a. Coalition opposes height limit exceptions at 75 Howard and 160 Folsom developments.
  - i. At 400 feet high and 240 feet high, the developments will cast shadows on Rincon Park throughout much of the year.
  - ii. Sierra Club and Coalition for San Francisco Neighborhoods oppose the height exceptions for these developments.
  - iii. Save Rincon Park Coalition asking for Milk Club support.

*A motion was made by Denise Dorey for the PAC to endorse the Save Rincon Park coalition. It was seconded by Jesus Barragan. Motion was approved 3-0, with 2 abstentions.*
