1720s	Construction of present Goldney House and boundary wall
1870s	Construction of terrace on North side of Ambra Vale East.
1940-41	Air raids; Houses destroyed by bombing.
1945-80	Bomb site – used car lot.
1980	Space taken over by local community, community garden established, crab apple trees planted.
1981	Post and rail fence erected.
1982	Flower beds established.
1984	Benches installed
1987	Wall built.
1991	Grass area laid down.
2009	Registered as a Town Green
2012	Daffodils planted, second level flattened, BBQ and picnic bench constructed in time for Diamond Jubilee.
2013	Summer House and Wendy House erected.
2014	Wood and earth steps to BBQ area built.
2015	Tool shed erected.
2018	Stone and brick paved areas, walls and steps constructed, steps to highest level improved. Gardened fenced off because of unsafe state of Goldney wall.
2019	Fencing removed. University replaces ferns to compensate for disruption.
2020	Covid-19 pandemic prevents social gatherings in the garden.
2021	Relaxing of Covid restrictions allows us to socialise subject to 'rule of six' from March 29 th 2021.
