

## **Harris County Republican Party Endorses Mike Knox, Willie Davis, Michael Kubosh and Anthony Dolcefino, and Eric Dick for Houston City Council**

WHEREAS, the City of Houston is in desperate need of common sense, fiscally conservative leadership that will focus on core services like public safety, streets, and drainage and that will take on the special interests at City Hall; and
