Our MISSION:

The mission of Health Care for All - Washington (HCFA-WA) is to achieve high quality, sustainable, affordable, publicly funded, publicly and privately delivered health care for all Washington residents.

Our GOAL:

To pass legislation built on the Universal Health Care Work Group recommendation and other legislation that moves our state towards publicly funded, universal health care.

STRATEGIES:

- A. Monitor and participate in the Universal Health Care Work Group to ensure that true publicly funded, universal health care is one of the recommendations of the work group, introducing elements of the Washington Health Security Trust.
- B. Protect advancements in health care coverage during this time of COVID-19 budget challenges, such as Cascade Care work group, insulin affordability work group, and other legislation.
- C. Research and support legislation to provide revenue to fund the UHCWG outcome, and to improve health care coverage.
- D. Work with grassroots, coalition partners, and key stakeholders to build momentum and statewide support for publicly funded universal health care.
- E. Work with legislators to advance promising legislation that died in 2020 but would have provided funding and advanced healthcare coverage.
- F. Educate and build a statewide network of supporters to become “health care voters.”
- G. Establish a FUNDRAISING plan with achievable goals and raise necessary funds to support our advocacy of, and lobbying for, universal health care.
- H. Address COMMUNICATIONS vehicles, including website, newsletter, e-Bulletin, blog and social media posts.
