This week, students applied multiplication and division strategies to solve for unknown variables using Pumpkin Math! We got our hands slimy and gooey by digging for pumpkin seeds to find out the total number of seeds in a pumpkin. Groups used the seeds they found to create arrays and equal groups and established fact families based on their visual representation. Altogether we found 571 seeds in our pumpkins!
