40/1516	Ball Park Sub-committee update Cllr Prestwood reported that: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Work at the site is underway and it is expected to be completed around the 22 May. • There have been a number of problems arranging a tour, but work is still on going. • The possibility of booking and usage policy is being explored by the Ball Park Sub-committee. • He has been in touch with PlasticsEco and it is unlikely that the level of funding previously offered will come through. Some smaller funding might be available though.

43/1516	<p>Residents' Group Newsletter</p> <p>After a lengthy discussion Cllr Prestwood, seconded by Cllr Beevers proposed that the Council would provide funds of £300 to the Residents' Group to ensure that a community newsletter is delivered in the Parish. That funding for the newsletter to be delivered outside the Parish should be sought from elsewhere by the Resident's Group. The £300 funding would be for one year only (i.e. until April 2016) and that issue would be reviewed at the Ordinary Meeting in March 2016.</p> <p>Resolved – Council unanimously supported Cllr Prestwood's proposal outlined above. A cheque for £300 was drawn and signed in the meeting and given to Cllr Hann to pass onto the Residents' Group.</p>
